Commission appointment

On 11 November the Commission appointed Mr Willy Schlieder to succeed Mr Ernst Albrecht as Director-General for Competition.

Mr Schlieder was born at Farnstädt (Germany) on 21 November 1926. He studied economics and law and took the main State examination in law at the University of Cologne, where he also received his degree of Doctor of Law.

From 1954 to 1958 Mr Schlieder was second legal adviser in the Central Executive of the Confederation of German Trade Unions. At the same time he practised law in Düsseldorf.

In 1958 he began to work for the Commission, where he was subsequently appointed Head of Division in the Directorate-General for Competition. Since July 1967 he has been Chief Executive Assistant to Mr Haferkamp, Vice-President of the Commission.
