Adoption of 13 new programmes

In Inforegio News for June 1997 we announced the adoption in principle of 14 programmes for declining industrial regions (Objective 2). All these programmes have now been finally adopted. In the mean time, the Commission has also definitively approved Community funding for 10 new programmes under Objective 2 as well as three programmes for revitalising declining urban areas (Community Initiative 'Urban'). Environmental projects financed by the Cohesion Fund

The Commission recently approved Community funding with a total volume of ECU 138 million for a new series of projects connected with the environment.

Portugal:

- ECU 22 million for solid waste treatment on the coast of the Norte region
- ECU 15 million for solid waste treatment in the Vale do Sousa (Norte)
- ECU 10 million for solid waste treatment in the Vale do Ave (Norte)
- ECU 6 million for the treatment of waste water at Vila Real de Santo Antonio (Algarve).

Ireland:

- · ECU 60.9 million for water collectors in Cork
- ECU 5.8 million for water supply in Limerick
- ECU 5.5 million for a national water conservation project.

Spain:

• ECU 11 million for cleaning-up the environment in the inter-commune area of Aljarafe (province of Seville)

Greece:

• ECU 1.5 million for drinking water supply in Veria.

Urban pilot projects

As part of the innovative schemes financed under Article 10 of the ERDF Regulation, money is given to projects which assist in the economic and social development of problem urban areas. In response to its call for proposals in November 1995, the Commission received more than 500 submissions and has selected 26 urban pilot projects which will each receive Community funding of between ECU 1.3 million and ECU 3.2 million.
