QUICK-FROZEN FOODSTUFFS

Article 5

- I. Unchanged.
 - 2. Unchanged.
 - 3. For a period of <u>eight years</u> from the notification of this Directive, the Member States may, for local distribution, authorize tolerances of up to 6°C.

Article 13

- II. 1. Unchanged.
 - 2. As regards display cabinets, for a period of <u>eight</u> years following notification of this Directive, Member States may retain the laws applying on the date when this Directive enters into force.

In this case, the Member State shall inform the Commission, stating the reasons for their decision.
