## OFFICIAL VISIT OF PRESIDENT THORN IN JAPAN (9-12 May)

SUBJECT: POSSILBE NEW NEGOTIATING ROUND.

STATEMENT BY PRESIDENT THORN IN ANSWER TO PRESS

QUESTIONS IN TOKYO ON 11 MAY.

## ZTEXT BEGINS:

REOUT A POSSIBLE NEW ROUND OF MULTILATERAL NEGOTIATIONS; I SHOULD LIKE TO BE CLEAR.

LET HE SAY STRAIGHT AWAY THAT THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION IS IN FAVOUR OF ANY EFFECTIVE ACTION WHICH CAN BE TAKEN TO SUPPORT AND STRENGTHEN THE INTERNATIONAL TRADING ORDER IN THE SECOND HALF OF THE 1980s, HE IN EUROPE DEPEND ON FREE TRADE FOR OUR PROSPERITY. HE HAVE A LIBERAL TRADE POLICY, HE NAME TO LIBERALIZE AND EXTEND TRADES OF THE IN GOODS AND IN SERVICES.

THE QUESTION IS: HOW TO ACHIEVE THIS RESULT? HOW BO HE GET LEVERYONE ON BOARD TO ACHIEVE THESE COMMON OBJECTIVES? THE TIMING AND THE METHOD AND THE ULTIMATE OBJECTIVES WILL BE CRUCIAL.

HE HILL ALSO NEED AN ADEQUATE INTERNATIONAL CONSENSUS. THEREFORE;
A STEP-BY-STEP APPROACH HILL BE HISE. THIS YEAR; HE SHOULD CONCENTRATE ON IMPLEMENTING THE EXISTING GATT HORK PROGRAMME; AND ON
ROLLING-BACK PROTECTIONISM.

NAVE SUGGESTED THAT IT MIGHT BE A GOOD IDEA TO HOLD A HIGH-EVEL GATT MEETING BEFORE THE END OF NEXT YEAR TO CONSIDER THE FUTURE. THERE HOULD BE NO PRE-CONDITIONS; NO STRINGS ATTACHED. BUT A NEW NEGOTIATING ROUND SHOULD BE THE MAIN TOPIC OF DISCUSSION.

BELIEVE - BUT WE WILL WANT TO DISCUSS THIS AMONG THE TEN NEXT

NEEK - THAT; IT WILL BE NECESSARY A) TO UNDERTAKE EXTENSIVE PRIOR

CONSULTATION WITH ALL GATT GOVERNMENTS AND B) TO BE CERTAIN THAT

AN ADEQUATE INTERNATIONAL CONSENSUS CAN BE REACHED ON THE TIMING

AND PRECISE OBJECTIVES; BEFORE HE CAN TAKE ANY DEFINITIVE POSI
TION IN REGARD TO THE LAUNCHING OF SUCH A NEW ROUND.

PRIME HINISTER NAKASONE AND I AGREED YESTERDAY THAT THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION AND THE JAPANESE AUTHORITIES SHOULD KEEP IN CLOSE COMMACT: EXCHANGING INFORMATION AND OPINIONS; AND MORKING TOGETHER IN A POSITIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE SPIRIT; IN THE HOPE THAT EFFECTIVE SECTION CAN BE TAKEN AT THE RIGHT MOMENT.
