BUDGET FIGURES 1984, 1985

The outline figures for the draft supplementary Budget 1984 and the Draft Budget 1985 are attached. These are unofficial figures. The two Budgets were adopted by the Council on 2 October (Tuesday last) and will be dealt with by the Parliament.

As announced on Wednesday (yesterday) the Commission has now paid the remaining 60% of EAGGF-Guarantee advances amounting to 1 045 Million Ecus. This would leave 1 439 Million Ecus for November and December - or 3 272 Million Ecus if the Supplementary Budget with an extra 1 833 Million Ecus for EAGGF-Guarantee is adopted.
