TEMPORARILY SUSPEND TRADE COUNTERMEASURES

Following contacts over the weekend between Willy De Clercq, member of the E.C. Commission responsible for External Relations, and Mr. Clayton Yeutter, U.S. Trade Representative, the United States and the European Community have jointly decided to suspend for one week the measures which they respectively envisioned on pasta, walnuts and lemons. Conforming to the request formulated by the E.C. Council of Ministers last June 18, the Commission will continue its contacts with American authorities to try to find an "amicable and equitable" solution.
