VIDEOTEX AND THE PRESS

Videotex is one of the best examples of innovative thinking applied to the dissemination of information. The innovation consists of using existing equipment (TV sets, telephone lines, computers, etc.), for a new purpose, i.e. making up-to-date information available around the clock to the general public.

Great interest was displayed in Videotex from the beginning because of its market potential. Public Videotex services were launched in Europe: Prestel in the United Kingdom in September 1979, Viditel in August 1980 in the Netherlands and in 1981 Bildschirmtext in the Federal Republic of Germany and Télétel in France. Experiments are under way in many other countries: Austria, Italy, Sweden, Finland, Norway, Spain, Switzerland, Japan, Canada and the USA.

After these few years of public experimentation, Videotex has arrived at a crossroads; it is in search of its identity. What was born as a means of information diffusion to the general public is now in the majority of cases exploited in the business and public information sector. Videotex has so far failed to reach the large public that was expected. One reason for this might be the still relatively high cost of the equipment. Hardware producers are reluctant to invest in the production of user's terminals in a field still in its infancy; we are therefore trapped in a vicious circle:

- hight costs mean few users;
- few users mean low market penetration;
- low market penetration means few information providers;
- few information providers (also) mean few users;
- few users mean low production runs;
- low production runs mean high costs, and so on.

On the other hand, the acceptance of Videotex by the general public will not only be affected by economic factors and by the improvement of technical means and information retrieving methods, but will depend above all on the ability that it will show in exploiting its distinctive features that make it different from the traditional information medium: the press.

The great advantages of Videotex are the possibility of making up-to-dated information available at all times of the day, shopping by catalogue order, making travel and hotel reservations, etc., while payments can be made by charging a credit card account. Future scenarios include the delivery of a personalised newspaper, holding opinion polls and even voting over local administrative issues.

These features are unique to Videotex and have very little in common with newspapers. Reading is not only getting information but it is also a pleasure, it is setting down in one's preferred armchair, it is reading at leisure (you cannot stare for hours at a screen).

There is therefore little reason for antagonism between Videotex and the press. Rather one could say that they are different means which are complementary in their purpose and social function.

Because of its topical interest and appeal to the large public, VIDEOTEX AND THE PRESS has been chosen as the subject of a seminar held in Luxembourg on 14 January 1982 and organized by the Directorate-General Information Market and Innovation of the Commission of the European Communities.

Learned Information, Oxford, will publish the proceedings of the seminar, complemented by a paper of R. HABER on the interfacing of Euronet and Videotex networks in Europe and a glossary of the most common terms used in telematics jargon.

Legislative, economic and social issues are raised by the introduction in daily and business life of telematics in general and of Videotex in particular. They are presented and discussed by representatives of the press from four countries in which Videotex plays a major role (U.K.; the Netherlands; Federal Republic of Germany, France).

The department is within Directorate A of the Directorate-General for the Information Market and Innovation (DG XIII) of the Commission of the European Communities. It has two principal roles. The first is to make available to all possible users the results of research and of studies of a scientific or technical nature, either carried out by the Commission in the laboratories of its Joint Research Centre or done elsewhere under contract with total or partial support from the Commission. The second role encompasses the whole sphere of scientific and technical publishing in the European Community: the department is concerned with the promotion of better communication of information between producers and users, by means that are both effective and efficient.

While specialists and businessmen are more concerned with technicalities and cost/profits analysis, the man-in-the-street, ranging from the greengrocer at the street corner to the decision maker (for instance a member of parliament) without the necessary technical background, does not often know how his social habits will be affected by the introduction of such new technologies and is often at loss when confronted with a completely new jargon which he does not understand.

This publication, by no means exhaustive in whatever respect, is meant as a contribution to a general awareness of our changing technological environment and its influence on every day life, and will be announced in a future issue of this Newsletter.

9. Electronic document delivery (2)

The Commission has encouraged the establishment of Euronet/DIANE, the Direct Information Access Network for Europe, which provides access to databases containing in electronic form either factual information or, in most cases, bibliographic references to documents. Consequently, the Commission is now going to encourage the establishment of facilities providing access to full documents in electronic form. The programme associated with this encouragement, is called ARTEMIS (Automatic Retrieval of Text from Europe's Multinational Information Service).

An exhibition and workshop was held on 18 and 19 December 1980 in Luxembourg at which systems and services relevant to electronic document delivery were presented and demonstrated. The workshop recommended that pilot experiments should be undertaken, especially to test user reactions.
