COMMISSION REPORT TO THE COUNCIL

on co-operation with European non-governmental organizations
(NGOs) active in the development field, with special
reference to the co-financing of projects (1985 budget)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. At a Council meeting on 28 November 1977, development ministers approved a procedure to be followed for the use of appropriations to cofinance projects with non-governmental organizations (NGOs).*

That procedure includes a stipulation that the Commission will present an annual report to the Council on the use of appropriations allocated during the preceding year.

The Commission accordingly presents this report on the use of the appropriations entered under Article 941 of the 1985 Community budget.

2. Although Article 941 relates solely to project cofinancing in developing countries and the raising of public awareness in the Community, other important areas of cooperation with NGOs are also covered in this report, such as food aid, emergency aid and inter-NGO coordination.

1. INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY

I. Cooperation between the European Community and the non-governmental organizations (NGOs) began in 1976 with the aim of adding a new dimension to the Community's development policy. The idea was to enable the Community to take an active part in the expression of solidarity shown by Europe at a non-official level towards the poorest sections of the population in the Third World. That objective was reflected initially in the establishment of a Community budget heading (Article 941) to finance projects in the developing countries with European NGOs. The appropriation, fixed on an experimental basis at 2.5 m ECU in 1976, increased progressively in subsequent years to cope with the increase in requests for cofinancing submitted by the NGOs. Accordingly, it reached 14 m ECU in 1981, doubled to 28 m ECU in 1982, and was then further increased to 31.2 m ECU in 1983 and 35.0 m ECU in 1984, at which level it was pegged for 1985.

Article 941 covers the cofinancing with NGOs of development projects in developing countries, and of projects to raise public awareness in Europe.

II. A review of Community cofinancing from the start of operations in developing countries shows that from 1976 to end 1985 the Community contribution totalled 174.2 m ECU and made it possible for 1.913 projects to be cofinanced in developing countries.

These projects were undertaken with 280 NGOs in 113 developing countries. A list of recipient countries with the respective Community contributions is given in Table I (annex).

The geographical breakdown shows that over the reference period 46.1% of the funds were allocated to African countries

south of the Sahara (1), 27.3% to Latin America (2), 20% to Asia, 6% to the Mediterranean area and 0.6% to the Pacific. ACP countries (3) were allocated 45% and non-ACP countries 55% of the total Community contribution.

Finally, 54% of the total available funds were allocated to developing countries with a per capita GNP of less than US\$ 500.

The total joint investment between NGOs and the Commission from 1976 to 1985 was around 431 m ECU, giving a multiplier effect of 2.5 times the Community contribution; in other words, the Community contribution accounts on average for 40% of joint NGO/Commission investment.

In addition, between 1978 and 1985 inclusive the Commission cofinanced 275 projects with 132 NGOs at a total cost of 11.0 m ECU to raise European public awareness of development issues.

In all, between 1976 and 1985, 2.188 projects were cofinanced under budget Article 941. The 2.000th project mark was therefore passed in the course of 1985, the tenth year of activity. It is worth noting that 45% of the projects were cofinanced and 59% of funds committed during the last three years (1983-85), evidence of the increasing interest which the Community is taking in this form of development cooperation.

Table II (annex) gives a breakdown by Member State of the total Community grant from 1976 to 1985 inclusive.

III. The cofinancing of development projects in developing countries and of projects to raise public awareness in Europe are, however, just two of the various forms of cooperation between NGOs and the Community. Other aspects, which are just as important, are cooperation in the distribution of food aid and in emergency operations, and the role of catalyst that the Commission continues to play in the context of inter-NGO cooperation at European level through a constant dialogue with NGOs, both individually and collectively.

In 1985, the total Community contribution to NGOs was of the order of 146.7 m ECU (42.4 m ECU for cofinancing and of projects to raise public awareness, 58.3 m ECU for food aid and 46.0 m ECU for emergency aid). This report sets out to give an account of the Commission's activities in 1985, dealing in turn with the various aspects of cooperation with NGOs while not forgetting contacts with other European institutions and the prospects and trends taking shape for 1986. It also presents the results, with comments, of an evaluation of various cofinanced projects carried out in 1984/85.

2. ALLOCATION OF COMMUNITY AID IN 1985

2.1. Cofinancing of NGO projects in developing countries (budget Article 941)

2.1.1. Commitments and payments

Commitment appropriations available under budget Article 941 amounted to 35.0 m ECU in 1985. To this was added 7.4 m ECU of commitment appropriations remaining from financial year 1984, making a total of 42.4 m ECU of commitment appropriations available for 1985.

During the year 505 project applications totalling 62.5 m ECU were submitted to the Commission. It was possible to cofinance 315 of these with a total Community contribution of 38.6 m ECU. Some 93 other projects, amounting to 11.1 m ECU, were not accepted or were withdrawn by the NGOs. The others, i.e. 97 admissible applications totalling 12.8 m ECU, had to be carried over to 1986.

Commitments under Article 941, including projects to raise public awareness and the Liaison Committee subsidy, totalled 42.4 m ECU. In other words, not only were 100% of the appropriations allocated in the 1985 budget committed, but all appropriations remaining from the previous financial year were also committed.

This demonstrates the NGOs ability to cope with a sum of the order of 42.0 m ECU in a single year.

Given those results, and the increasing number of applications - many of which had to be turned down for lack of funds - plus inflation and the fact that Spanish and Portuguese NGOs are eligible for cofinancing from 1 January 1986, an increase in Article 941 appropriations in 1986 and 1987 budgets would seem essential.

Table III of the annex gives the breakdown by Member State of the 1985 allocation.

The total payments of 30 m ECU effected in 1985 (compared with 25.3 m ECU in 1984) comprise 12.0 m ECU of commitments from 1985 and 18.0 m ECU of commitments from the preceding years.

2.1.2. Type and scale of projects; block grants

Table IV in the annex gives a complete list of the 315 projects cofinanced in 1985 in developing countries.

As in the past, the project content is extremely varied and continues to be broken down into three main traditional sectors, namely rural development, training and health. Most of the projects, however, fall within more than one sector, reflecting the integrated approach which is characteristic of NGO operations.

As regards the scale of the projects cofinanced, the Commission's average contribution was 123.000 ECU in 1985, as against 115.000 ECU in 1984. Although the Community contribution can be as much as 360.000 ECU over three years, it was above 250.000 ECU in only 35 cases, whereas in 64 cases it was less than 50.000 ECU (excluding block grants). This confirms once more the NGOs' penchant for small-scale operations, which is in fact one of the main reasons for their success.

The 315 development projects cofinanced in 1985 included 43 block grants amounting to 3.7 m ECU. It is worth noting the trend in block grants over the last few years:

The figures given above point to the progressive increase in block grants both in absolute terms and as a percentage of the total budget. This is in line with the wishes expressed and repeatedly confirmed by the NGOs in recent years. The sums allocated in block grants should increase further in 1986.

The figures also reveal the veritable burgeoning of mini-operations, to which the Commission is increasingly able to contribute, thanks to the "capillary" approach which, as has already been pointed out, is a feature of the non-governmental organizations' activity.

2.1.3. Population concerned and recipient countries

The 315 development projects cofinanced in 1985 were carried out in 90 developing countries. The geographical breakdown shows that of the allocated funds 44% went to African countries south of the Sahara (1), 33% to Latin America (2), 20% to Asia, 2.5% to the Mediterranean area, and 0.5% to the Pacific area.

Of the total Community grant aid, 15.9 m ECU (41%) went to ACP countries and 22.7 m ECU (59%) to non-ACP developing countries.

In 1985, 45% of the total appropriations available were allocated to countries with a per capita GNP of less than US\$ 500. However, it must be stressed once more that cofinanced projects are aimed by definition at the poorest sections of the population in developing countries, the country's per capita GNP being of only fairly relative significance in practice.

In general, the breakdown of appropriations in 1985 continues to reflect a trend towards a wider variety of beneficiaries.

2.2. Cofinancing of projects undertaken by NGOs to raise European public awareness of development issues (budget Article 941)

1985 brought confirmation of the importance of the awareness projects carried out by NGOs with financial support from the Commission.

In the course of the year, 66 projects were cofinanced with 53 NGOs for a total of 3.5 m ECU (the equivalent of 8% of the annual appropriation under budget Article 941); this represents a clear advance on 1984, when the total sum for the projects cofinanced in this sphere was 2.9 m ECU, i.e. 7% of the available appropriation.

Table V (annex) gives a complete list of the projects cofinanced in 1985.

An analysis of the 66 projects shows that the main areas covered were general development issues (19 projects), food and agriculture (13), industrial restructuring and international trade (8), the role of women (6), the environment (4), health (3), and Southern Africa (3).

The projects were aimed at a range of target groups. In addition to the 23 projects aimed at public opinion in general, they included schools (14 projects), the farming sector (10), industry (4), and the young (5); for further details, see Table VI (annex).

A comparison of these figures with those for 1984 reflects the general responsiveness of the NGOs to European public opinion and its need for information and awareness in response to changing events. In 1984, when negotiations for the renewal of the Lome Convention were under way, 7 projects were concerned with development-related Community policies, while in 1985, a year of widespread famine in Africa, as many as 23 projects featured themes with a direct bearing on the African crisis: food and agriculture, the environment, health, and the image of developing countries and their culture in the European media.

This provides confirmation of the NGOs' consistent policy of supplying the public with balanced, reasonable explanations of the often sensational stories put out about various aspects of under-development. The NGOs also stress the need for the Community to do more to inform the public about its own development policies.

Given the relatively small sums available for cofinancing these operations, the Commission feels greater efforts must be made to improve coordination between NGOs and their various operations. More awareness of each other's programmes and more pooling of individual efforts would be bound to enhance the effectiveness of the resources deployed in pursuit of common aims, while not compromising the essential and valuable diversity of these organizations or their local or national characteristics.

2.3. Community food aid channelled through NGOs (budget Chapter 92)

2.3.1. General

Euroaid again played a crucial part in organizing and administering the transport and distribution of food aid. Efforts have been made to improve cooperation and co-ordination between Euroaid and the Commission. In this connection the Commission had an opportunity to talk directly to a majority of the NGOs involved in food aid at a seminar arranged by Euroaid and held in the Netherlands in September 1985. The seminar, originally intended as a one-off event, was so successful that the participants have asked Euroaid to plan a similar encounter this year, so that they can keep abreast of Community working methods and policies. In accordance with the Council resolution, The Commission urged NGOs to gear food aid operations to development rather than relief measures. The 1985 programme showed a clear trend in that direction, with about 40% of the total tonnage devoted to development projects as compared with approximately 17% in 1984.

2.3.2. Ordinary food aid

Under the Community's normal food aid programme for 1985 the following products, to a total value of about 45.7 m ECU, were distributed in 50 developing countries via 35 European NGOs: 50.000 t of cereals, 23.000 t of skimmed milk powder, 1.350 t of sugar, 850 t of butteroil, 1.100 t of vegetable oil, 1.950 t of beans and 650 t of dried fish. This is 1.7 m ECU down on the 1984 total, owing to the decrease

in the quantity of butteroil. Cereals, on the other hand, were up by 15.000 t, vegetable oil by 600 t, beans by 450 t and dried fish by 250 t. There was no change in the quantity of milk powder supplied. The sugar allocation was down by 50 t and butteroil by 650 t.

2.3.3. Emergency food aid

A total of 19.160 t of cereals, 570 t of skimmed milk powder, 1.750 t of butteroil, 1.600 t of sugar, 1.820 t of beans, 400 t of dried fish, 40 t of high-energy biscuits and 5 t of protein-enriched milk bars to a value of 12.6 m ECU were allocated to NGOs in 1985 for emergency food aid operations.

The NGOs continued to play a noteworthy part in assisting drought victims in sub-Saharan countries. A number of emergency relief operations were approved for the benefit of Ethiopian refugees, involving 6.610 t of cereals, 500 t of skimmed milk powder, 1.500 t of butteroil, 1.450 t of beans, and 40 t of high-energy biscuits, worth a total of 7.3 m ECU.

The NGOs also undertook emergency relief operations in other parts of the world. Following the earthquake in Chile, Caritas Germanica was able to distribute food immediately from its stocks, which were later replenished by a shipment of 2.250 t of emergency food aid. Trocaire, on behalf of CIDSE, purchased and supplied rice and fish within a month of the approval of the relevant decision, to help high-risk groups

in Cambodia and Vietnam, victims respectively of flooding, leading to food shortages, and a particularly destructive series of typhoons.

The continual fighting in Lebanon increased the number of displaced persons being cared for by various small NGOs, which requested and were sent, through the World Council of Churches, 70 t of skimmed milk powder.

Throughout the year the NGOs were instrumental in helping the Commission transport and distribute its own emergency aid under the Dublin Plan, particularly in the Sudan.

Table VII (annex) shows the breakdown by NGO and recipient country of the main food aid operations in 1985.

2.4. Community emergency aid channelled through NGOs (budget Article 950, Article 137 of the Lome Convention and Article 117 of the Council Decision on the association of the OCT)

In 1985, 195 m ECU was available for emergency aid operations. Most activity was centred on implementation of the Dublin Plan approved at the end of 1985, which provided 175 m ECU of assistance for drought-hit African countries. Of that sum, 36 m ECU (20%) was channelled through 24 NGOs, and a similar amount went to branches of the Red Cross organization. With their support it proved possible to carry out a variety of auxiliary operations to back up the supply of basic foodstuffs and fulfil more specific needs: nutritional rehabilitation, supplementary feeding, inland transport, out-of-season crops, and the production and distribution of dried meat, etc.

In addition to the Dublin Plan, emergency aid to the tune of 10 m ECU (half of the total available) was channelled through 20 NGOs, and another 5 m ECU went to the Red Cross.

The Commission also carried out emergency aid operations in conjunction with the UNHCR and various governments, and many NGOs indirectly received Community funds via these channels.

Another feature of 1985 was the development of European Community Emergency Programmes. These involve a number of NGOs whose operations are financed and coordinated by the Commission, which allocates specific tasks to be carried out in view of a single objective. Such programmes have been successfully implemented in Sudan, Vietnam, Colombia and Mozambique.

Table VIII (annex) gives a breakdown of emergency aid for 1985 by implementing agency and Table IX lists the operations for the year.

2.5. Support for inter-NGO coordination and miscellaneous activities at European level (budget Article 941)

In 1985, 130 NGOs (42 of them for the first time) benefited from at least one cofinancing. This compares with 117 and 34 respectively in 1984, thus confirming the trend towards diversification, which is actively encouraged by the Commission.

The instruments set up in previous years for the democratic representation of European NGOs and dialogue between them (National Assemblies, European General Assembly, Liaison Committee) continued to play their institutional role in the course of 1985.

The Liaison Committee was allocated 324.000 ECU in 1985 to cover its operating costs. As in the past, this includes both the Committee's own activities and the various advisory, organizational and coordination tasks that are carried out throughout the year by its subcommittees (which are responsible respectively for raising public awareness, food aid, emergency operations and volunteers). A fifth subcommittee on cofinancing was set up in 1985.

The Liaison Committee's 1985 grant was of the same order of magnitude as those it received in 1983 (318.431 ECU) and 1984 (298.133 ECU).

Contacts were made throughout the year with Spanish and Portuguese NGOs. The organizations contacted in the two new Member States have been informed about Community procedures and the types of cooperation the Commission can offer, and some have already submitted a number of requests for cofinancing.

In both Portugal and Spain a number of NGOs have already set up collective organizations similar to the other Member States' national assemblies. They have elected representatives, who will be taking part for the first time as full members in the April 1986 European General Assembly. Spanish and Portuguese members, elected by the NGOs of their respective countries have been sitting on the Liaison Committee since January.

3. EVALUATION OF COFINANCED PROJECTS

As foreshadowed in last year's report, evaluation of cofinanced projects was under way throughout 1985. The results of this operation, which were published at the end of the year, are significant and are worth commenting on here.

This second independent evaluation exercise (the first took place in 1980-81) covered 32 projects (25 projects cofinanced with NGOs and seven EDF microprojects) completed or under way in 17 developing countries in Africa (19 projects), Latin America (8) and Asia (5). The operation was coordinated by the Belgian non-governmental organization COTA (Collectif d'Echanges pour la Technologie Appropriée) in close liaison with the Commission, the NGOs and the NGO Liaison Committee. Each project's performance was judged in the light of four main criteria: effectiveness, efficiency, viability and impact on development. The method adopted gives particular weight to interaction between the project and its overall social and economic context rather than the quantitative aspects of operations. The selected factors would appear to have been analysed with exceptional thoroughness by comparison with the usual run of evaluation exercises (most of the assessors spent a month on each of the projects, most of which were located in particularly remote villages).

Some of the conclusions and recommendations were addressed to the Commission, including the recommendation that the criteria for selecting projects be reviewed in order to adapt them more closely to the specific nature and requirements of the NGOs. It is worth pointing out that a review of the general rules governing cofinancing is under way; it will be pursued in close consultation with the NGOs, notably with the Liaison Committee and more particularly with the recently established subcommittee on cofinancing. On some of the recommendations (e.g. increase in the percentage of the budget earmarked for block grants, acceptance of projects lasting more than three years) there is already a broad agreement of principle on both sides.

Other recommendations are addressed more directly to the NGOs. Indeed, although the authors of the evaluation report stress the validity of the NGOs' approach and the satisfactory performance of most of the projects, they felt it worthwhile to reaffirm a number of principles and criteria by which each NGO should be guided at all times in the design, selection and execution of projects. The assessors list a number of conditions which were met by the most successful of the projects covered by the evaluation. These conditions should therefore be applied by all external aid donors concerned to ensure that their projects make a lasting and tangible impact:

- the ultimate beneficiaries and their real needs should be identified clearly;
- the beneficiaries should be involved from the design stage onwards and steps should be taken to ensure that they make an active contribution to the execution of the project and also that they are capable of managing it when the external aid comes to an end;
- the nature of the social and economic relations existing between beneficiary groups must be grasped accurately;
- regular supplies of inputs must be ensured, while avoiding dependence on external aid;
- it is necessary to be sure that there will be a reliable and adequate demand for the products or services supplied by the project;
- measures must be taken to see to the transfer of appropriate technical know-how;
- opportunities for the replication and diffusion of the project must be taken into account from the earliest stage of the project.

These criteria fully reflect the spirit of partnership between the people of North and South, which is precisely the distinguishing feature of the NGOs. It seemed advisable to recapitulate them in this report, since adherence to them by the NGOs - and also by the Commission when selecting projects for cofinancing - consti-

tutes a guarantee in some measure of the success of operations undertaken jointly. Along with the consolidation and quantitative expansion of cofinancing that has been a feature of recent years, it is essential also to maintain and improve further the quality and effectiveness of cofinanced projects

4. INSTITUTIONAL CONTACTS

Through its Committee on Development and Cooperation, Parliament continued in 1985 its contacts with the NGO Liaison Committee. Topics on the agenda included Commission/NGO cofinancing, alternative operations in place of food aid, emergency aid, conditions for immigrants in Europe and the struggle against racism, indebtedness in the Third World and the situation in southern Africa.

As part of these contacts, Parliament instructed Mr. J. Ulburghs MEP to draw up a report on cooperation between the NGOs and the Commission in the development field. The report is now being drafted and will probably be discussed by Parliament in the first half of 1986.

The Council Working Party on Development Cooperation took note in November 1985 of the Commission's annual report on the various aspects of cooperation between the Commission and NGOs in 1984.

5. CONCLUSION AND PROSPECTS

Even more than in 1984, one of the main features of 1985 was the stepping-up of Community operations to alleviate the effects of the famine in Africa, with the NGOs playing a very active part. These operations must obviously continue in 1986, though with increasing emphasis being placed on rehabilitation and development proper.

With regard to budget Article 941, 1985 saw not only the commitment in full of the appropriations entered in the budget but also the take-up of the whole of the uncommitted balance from previous years. In other words, the NGOs demonstrated their capacity to absorb over 42 million ECU in the course of a single budget year. In the light of this, and given the increasing volume of applications for cofinancing submitted by the NGOs, it would seem essential for the appropriations under Article 941 to be increased in the 1986 and 1987 budgets.

In 1986 the Spanish and Portuguese NGOs will be eligible for Community cofinancing and will be able to cooperate on both an institutional and an operational basis with NGOs in other Member States. They will bring with them new ideas and new partners in the developing countries, and also the weight of their experience.

Lastly, as well as consolidating and expanding cofinancing, both the NGOs and the Commission will endeavour to maintain and improve further in 1986 the quality and effectiveness of operations undertaken jointly.
